CTP/CCM Working Group on Taiwanese Access Points

The CTP and CCM chairs have proposed a new working group on Taiwanese Access Points to the CEAL Executive Board. If approved, this new group would examine issues related to Taiwanese access points in the LC/National Authority File, OCLC and online catalogs (i.e. mixed practices, confusing and problematic headings that hamper access). The proposal is for the group to include several experienced librarians, and achieve its objectives in a one-year term.
