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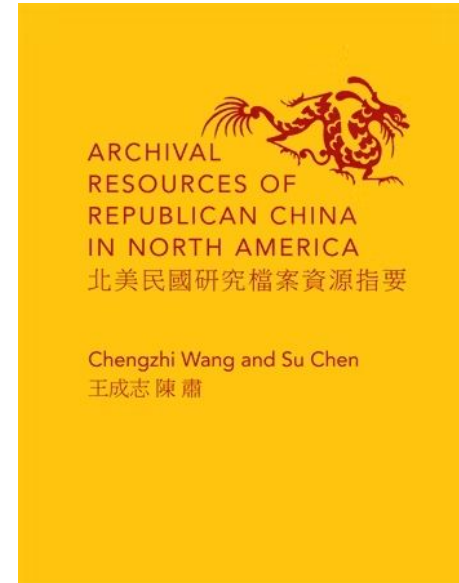
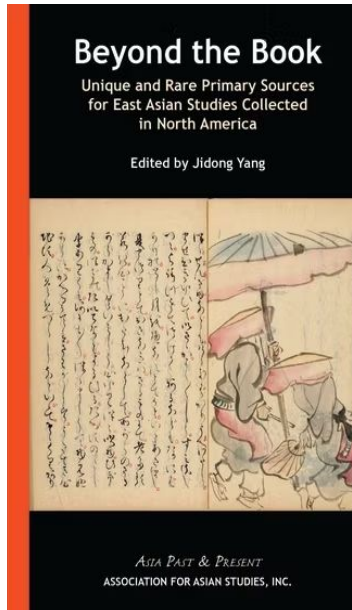

State of the Field: Accomplishments and Gaps

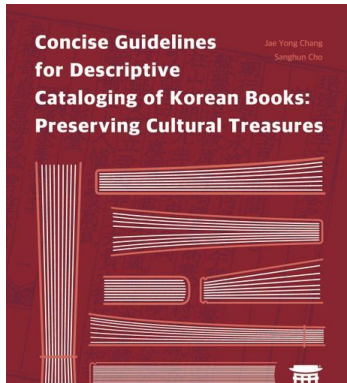
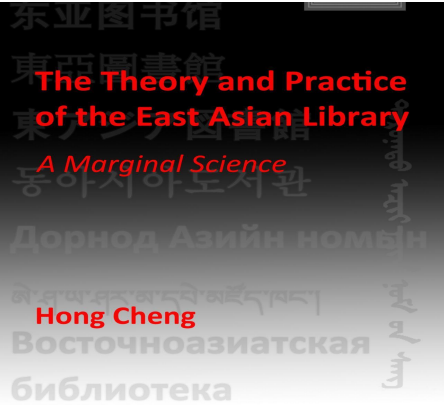
Growth of East Asian Collections

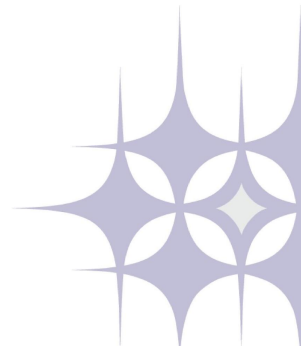

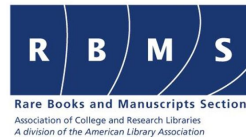


GUIDELINES FOR PRIMARY SOURCE LITERACY

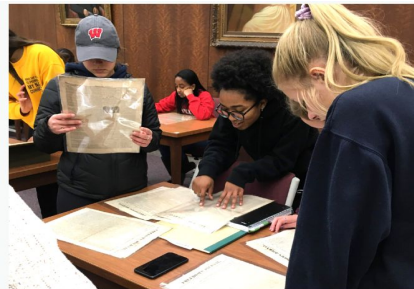

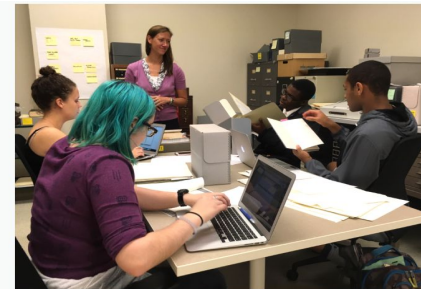
